

Welcome! We are looking forward to working with your student this year. To assist in your students' growth in math please provide materials and review the expectations with your student.

**Materials Needed:**

- Math divider in your main 3 ring binder
- Graph paper spiral (preferably a metal coil bound one, the others tend to fall apart)
- Loose-leaf **graph** paper and regular paper for homework
- Pencils
- Pens both red & black
- Basic Calculator
- Ruler

**Math Team Assessment and Homework/Classwork Policy:**

- Classwork and homework will be worth 20% of a student's overall grade. It will be given regularly and expected to be completed on time. When homework is not completed on time, the discussions that follow are not meaningful to the students who have not done the work and are not familiar with the problems. **Only completed assignments with work shown will be accepted. Homework that is not complete will be handed back to finish and recorded as HB (handed back) until it is completed and turned back in.**
  - Semester grades will be cumulative and will not start over each 6-weeks.
- Assessments will be worth a total of 80% of a student's overall grade. Quizzes will be worth 20% and may not be retaken and Unit Tests will be worth 60% and there will be an opportunity for one retake only after all of the homework from that unit is completed and turned in.
- **Grading Scale for Assessments:**
  - 4: Advanced proficiency of standard
  - 3: Proficiency of standard level
  - 2: Basic proficiency of standard
  - 1: Below Basic proficiency of standard level
- **Grading Scale for Homework:**
  - 4: Completed on time at a proficient level
  - 3: Completed on time at a basic proficient level
  - 2: Late but completed at a proficient level
  - 1: Late but completed at a basic proficient level
  - 0: Incomplete/No Work Shown
- The grading scale is as follows due to the standards based grading system:
  - A 87.5% - 100%
  - B 69.0% - 87.4%
  - C 50.1% - 68.9%
  - D 37.7% - 50.0%
  - F Below 37.7%
