Attend – When it's class time, concert time, field-trip time be there for the team.

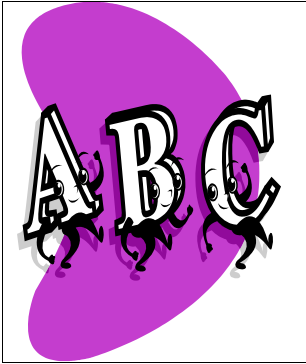
When to/not talk – Know when and when not to talk!

Grading Policy



There are 3 components that comprise the scoring system in choir.

1. Daily attendance to class, sectionals, and other designated events.
2. Theory quizzes, voice testing, assignments.
3. Concert performance.

Choir classes are performance based. Students will receive a performance schedule the beginning of each semester. The only excuses for missing a concert are serious illness, family emergency, an extended absence that has been pre-excused through the school office. The director must be notified in advanced 2 weeks for the absence to be excused, except in an emergency situation.

Make-up work can be done for excused absences. Unexcused absences can only get partial points on a make-up assignment as in life we have natural consequences for lack of responsibility and planning
